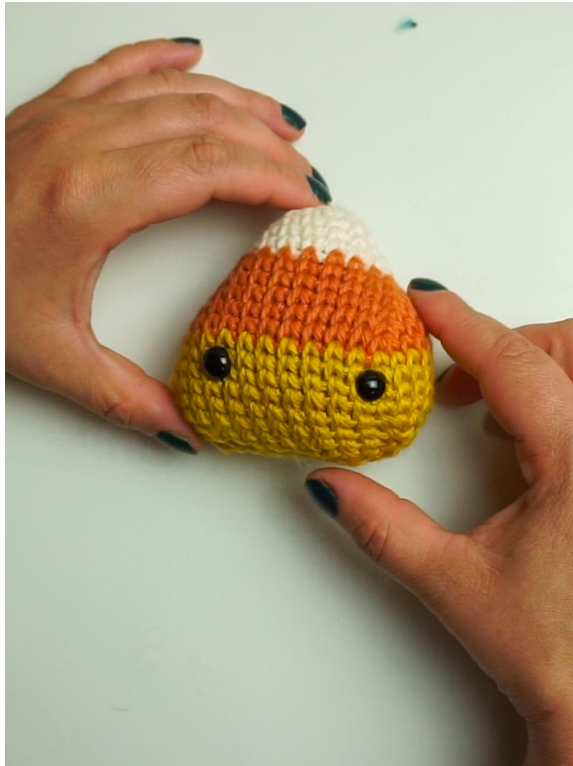


PATTERN

Candy Corn



Abbreviations

- sc - single crochet
- wc - waistcoat stitch
- inc - increase waistcoat stitch
- dec - decrease waistcoat stitch

Waistcoat Stitch

The waistcoat stitch is what creates a great, dense fabric for this project and keeps all but the most determined cats from pulling stuffing loose.

A waistcoat stitch is worked identically to a single crochet, except you go **through** the post of the next single crochet, under the horizontal bar and between the legs

Yarn **Color A - Sugarwheel Cotton Solids:**
Linen (or DK weight White Cotton Yarn)

Color B - Sugarwheel Cotton Solids:
Tangerine (or DK weight Orange Cotton Yarn)

Color C - Sugarwheel Cotton Solids:
Daffodil Days (or DK weight Yellow Cotton Yarn)

Hook **Size F/5 -3.75mm Hook**

Gauge **None**

Extras **Stuffing, Catnip (optional), Scissors, 12mm Safety Eyes**

Instructions

Use Color A

Magic Ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in Magic Ring

Rnd 2: inc * (12)

Rnd 3: 1 inc, 5 wc * (14)

Rnd 4: 1 inc, 6 wc * (16)

Rnd 5: 1 inc, 7 wc * (18)

Rnd 6: 1 inc, 8 wc * (20)

Use Color B

Rnd 7: 1 inc, 9 wc * (22)

Rnd 8: 1 inc, 10 wc * (24)

Rnd 9: 1 inc, 11 wc * (26)

Rnd 10: 1 inc, 12 wc * (28)

Rnd 11: 1 inc, 13 wc * (30)

Rnd 12: 1 inc, 14 wc * (32)

Use Color C

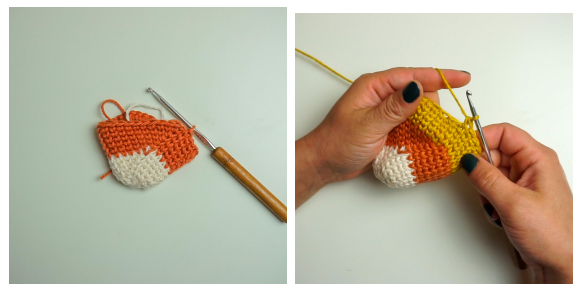
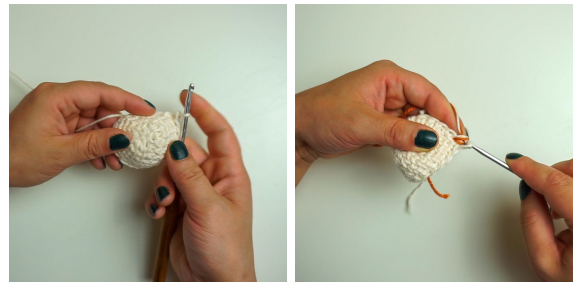
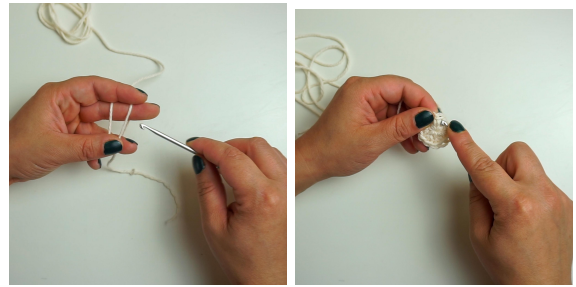
Rnd 13-16: 1 wc * (32)

Rnd 17: 3 dec, 10 wc * (26)

Rnd 18: dec, 11 wc * (24)

Rnd 19: 2 dec, 8 * (20)

Rnd 20: dec, 8 * (18)



Assembly

If you have safety eyes, install them now, before you stuff the candy corn, I placed them around round 14.

Stuff your candy corn with polyfill, catnip, or recycled scraps! Hold the sides together side by side and whip stitch the two sides together.

Secure the tail, cut, and pull through the body of the candy corn to hide.
