Yarn Color A - Sugarwheel Cotton Solids: Body Color (or any DK weight Cotton Yarn)

Color B - Sugarwheel Cotton Solids: White Eye Color (or any DK weight Cotton Yarn)

Color C - Sugarwheel Cotton Solids: Eye
Outline Color (or any DK weight Cotton
Yarn)

Hook Size F/5 -3.75mm Hook

Gauge None

Extras **Stuffing**, **Scissors**, **Safety Eyes**, **Needle**

Abbreviations

- sc single crochet
- wc waistcoat stitch
- inc increase waistcoat stitch
- dec decrease waistcoat stitch
- hdc half double crochet
- () repeat around or number of times specified

Waistcoat Stitch

The waistcoat stitch is what creates a great, dense fabric for this project.

A waistcoat stitch is worked identically to a single crochet, except you go **through** the post of the next single crochet, under the horizontal bar and between the legs



Instructions

Use Color A

Magic Ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in Magic Ring - 6

Rnd 2: (wc, inc, wc) around - 8

Rnd 3: (wc, 2 inc, wc) around - 12

Rnd 4: (wc, inc, 2 wc, inc, wc) around - 16

Rnd 5: (wc) around - 16

Rnd 6: (wc, inc, 4 wc, inc, wc) - 20

Rnd 7: (wc) around - 20

Rnd 8: (wc, inc, 6 wc, inc, wc) around - 24

Rnd 9-12: (wc) around - 24

** The first and last two stitches of round 13 are worked with the piece held shut together and through stitches on both sides.

Rnd 13: 2 wc through both front and back pieces, 7 wc worked through just the front piece of the squid, 2 wc through both front and back. Ch 1 to secure, cut tail and pull through.

** Re-attach **Color A** at the beginning of the back stitches left untouched in the previous round

Rnd 14: 7 wc, inc in the side of the stitch across the opening, 7 wc, inc in the side of the stitch across the opening

Rnd 15-17: (wc) around - 18

Rnd 18: sc, (3 hdc in next stitch, sl st) repeat for a total of 4 times, sc (3 hdc in next stitch, sl st) repeat for a total of 4 times - 8 tentacles sl st, cut tail, and pull through to secure.

Attach safety eyes. Embroider around eyes with **Color B** with a chain stitch. Make a second pass around the bottom of the eyes and fill in any space between the eyes.

Using **Color C**, embroider with a chain stitch around the outside of the whites of the eyes, going around the bottom half a second time.

With **Color C**, chain 8, cut tail and pull through to secure. If you want to add a keyring, do it now and use the tails to attach the loop to the top of the squid and hide ends inside.

Stuff squid lightly.

Re-attach **Color A**, slip stitch across row 18 holding both sides together to close the bottom. Cut tail and pull through to secure.
