Yarn **Worsted Weight Yarn** in colors:

White (or cream)

Black

Gray

Red

Gold

*Note: I used peaches and cream cotton for everything but the grey. It gives good definition and shape but isn't very soft and looks pretty hole-y.

Hook **Size F/5 -3.75mm Hook**

Gauge **None**

Extras **Scissors, Stuffing, Yarn Needle**

Abbreviations

- ch - chain
- sc - single crochet
- dec - decrease single crochet
- inc - increase single crochet
- hdc - half double crochet
- hdc super dec - see below
- dc - double crochet
- sk st - skip stich
- sl st - slip stich
- () - repeat the stitches in the parenthesis, either around or the number of times given

hdc super dec

Yarn over, insert hook in specified stitch and draw up a loop; three loops on the hook. Insert into next stitch and draw up a loop, insert into next stitch and draw up a loop. Yarn over and pull through all loops on hook.

Then, repeat but only in the next two hdc. You're decreasing the first three hdc into one, then the next two into one. This pulls the shell into a large puff.

Instructions

Cape

Using Black

Chain 26

Row 1 - hdc across - 24

Sl st

Secure tail and pull through

Using Red

Row 1: sc across, turn - 24

Row 2: (inc, 3 sc), turn - 30

Row 3: sc across, turn - 30

Row 4: (inc, 4 sc), turn - 36

Row 5: sc across, turn - 36

Row 6: (inc, 5 sc), turn - 42

Row 6: sc across, turn - 42

Row 7: (2 sc, hdc, 4 dc in next stitch, hdc, 2 sc) * 2 sc - 60

Using White

Sl st across - 60

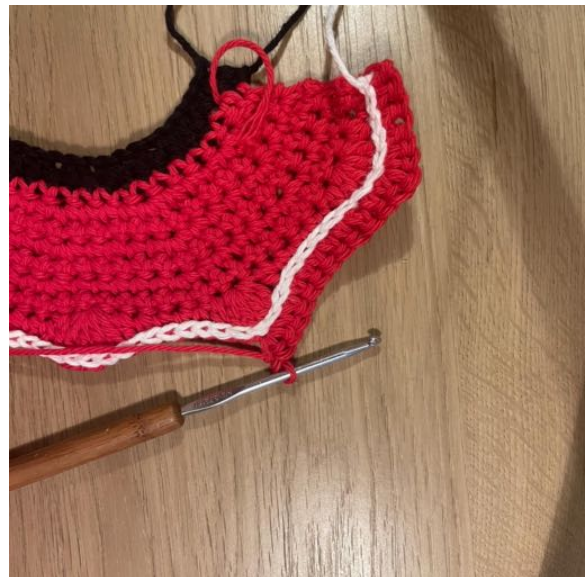
Slip stitch, cut tail, and pull through to secure

Back to Red,

Row 8: (4 sc, 3 sc in next stitch, 5 sc) * - 78

Cut tail and pull through to secure

Weave in ends



Body

Using White

Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring

Rnd 2: (inc) around - 12

Rnd 3: (inc, 1 sc) around - 18

Rnd 4: (inc, 2 sc) around - 24

Rnd 5: (inc, 3 sc) around - 30

Rnd 6: (sk st, 5 dc in next st, sk st, 2 sc) around
- 6 scallops

Rnd 7: (5 hdc, dec) around - 36

Rnd 8: (hdc super dec, sc) around - 18

Rnd 9: Rnd 6: (5 dc in next st, sk st, sc)
around - 6 scallops

Rnd 10: (5 hdc, sc) around - 36

Rnd 11: (hdc super dec, sc) around - 18

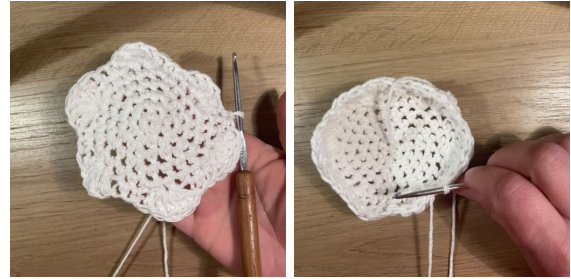
Rnd 12: sc around - 18

stuff

Rnd 13: (dec, 1 sc) - 12

Rnd 14: (dec) - 6

Slip stitch, cut long tail and pull through to secure. Weave the tail into the stitches around the 6sc circle and pull to close.



Bell

With gold

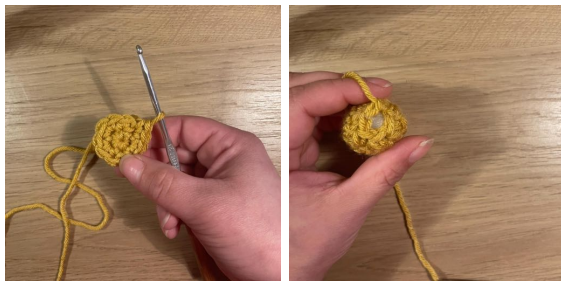
Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring

Rnd2: (Inc) around - 12

Rnd 3-4: (Sc) around - 12

Rnd 5: (dec) around - 6

Cut 12" tail and pull through last stitch to secure. Weave around opening and pull to tighten.



Ears (make 2)

Using Grey

Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (Inc) around - 12

Rnd 3: (Inc, sc) around - 18

Rnd 4: (Inc, 2 sc) around - 24

Slip stitch, cut long tail and pull through to secure. Fold in half to prepare to attach.



Horns (make 2)

Using Brown

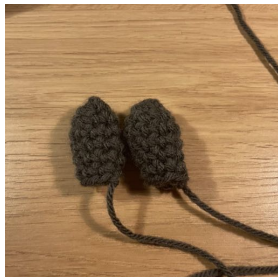
Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (Inc, sc) around - 9

Rnd 3-6: Sc around - 9

Slip stitch, cut long tail and pull through to secure. Stuff lightly.



Arms (make 2)

With Grey

Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, sc) around - 9

Rnd 3-15: (sc) around - 9

Stuff

Slip stitch, cut long tail and pull through to secure. We'll use this tail to sew the arms to the body

Legs (make 2)

With Grey

Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring

Rnd 2: (inc) around - 12

Rnd 3-6: (sc) around - 12

Rnd 7: (dec, 2 sc) around - 9

Rnd 8-13: (sc) around - 9

Stuff

Slip stitch, cut long tail and pull through to secure. We'll use this tail to sew the legs to the body.



Eyes (make 2)

Using Black

Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring

Rnd 2: (inc) around - 12

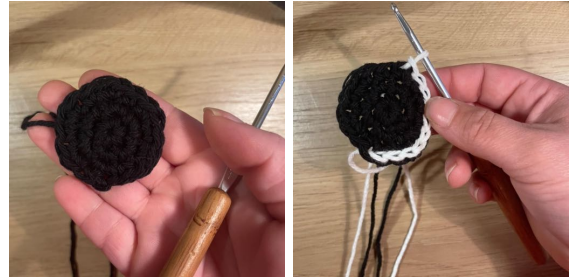
Rnd 3: (inc, 1 sc) around - 18

Slip stitch, cut extra long tail and pull through to secure.

Using White

Rnd 4: 10 sl st around, cut extra long tail, pull through to secure

Using a large tapestry needle, use the long white tail to come up through the magic ring and down through the middle slip stitch three times. Secure with knot on the back of the eye.



Head

Using Grey

Make magic ring

Rnd1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (Inc) around - 12

Rnd 3: (Inc, sc) around - 18

Rnd 4: (Inc, 2 sc) around - 24

Rnd 4: (Inc, 3 sc) around - 30

Rnd 5: (Inc, 4 sc) around - 36

Rnd 6: (Inc, 5 sc) around - 42

Rnd 7-15: (sc) around - 42

Rnd 16: (dec, 5 sc) around - 36

Rnd 17: (dec, 4 sc) around - 30

Rnd 18: (dec, 3 sc) around - 24

Rnd 19: (dec, 2 sc) around - 18

Stuff

Rnd 20: (dec, 1 sc) around - 12

Rnd 21: (dec) around - 6

Cut tail and pull through. Sew around circle and pull tight to close.

Sew horns and ears to head.

Sew the horns at around row 5-7 and ears at rows 12-14. I like to place the ears a little further back from the horns.



Head Fleece

Using White

Make magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring

Rnd 2: (Inc) around - 12

Rnd 3: (Inc, sc) around - 18

Rnd 4: (Inc, 2 sc) around - 24

Rnd 4: (Inc, 3 sc) around - 30

Rnd 5: (Inc, 4 sc) once, chain 3, sk 2 st, 3 sc, (Inc, 4 sc) twice, chain 3, sk 2 st, 3 sc, (Inc, 4 sc) once - 36

Rnd 6: inc, sc to first ch 3 space, 5 sc in ch 3 space, 3 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 4 sc, 5 sc in ch 3 space, 3 sc, inc, 5 sc - 42

Rnd 7: (inc, 6 sc) around - 48

Rnd 8: (inc, 7 sc) twice, 4 hdc in next st, sl st, sk st, 5 dc in next st, sl st, sk st, 4 hdc in next st, (inc, 7 sc) 3 times - 59

Rnd 9: sc to first hdc, 4 hdc, sl st, 5 hdc, sl st, 4 hdc together, ch 1 to close puff, sc around to beginning of the round - 56

Rnd 10: sc to first hdc, 4 hdc together, ch 1 to close puff, sl st, hdc super dec, sl st, sc around to beginning of round - 53

*Note: place stitch markers 7 stitches to each side of the middle hair puff

Rnd 11: sc to marker, ch 1, turn

Rnd 12: sk st, sc to other marker, ch 1, turn

Rnd 13: sk st, sc to end of rnd 11, ch 1, turn



Rnd 14: sk st, 8 sc, ch 5, sk 2 st, sc to 10 st before end of rnd, ch 5, sk 2 st, 8 sch, ch 1, turn

Rnd 15: sk st, sc to first ch 5 space, sl st across space, sc to next ch 5 space, sl st across space, sc to end of rnd, ch 1, turn - you should have roughly 42 stitches, if not, it's not too important just adjust the beginning and end sc of the next round to make things fit

Rnd 16: 2 sc, (sk st, 5 dc in next st, sk st, 2 sc) around, ch 1, turn - 8 scallops

Rnd 17: 2 sc, (5 hdc, dec) 8 times, 2 sc, ch 10 - 62

Rnd 17: dec, (hdc super dec, sc) 8 times, dec, 10 sc - 36

Rnd 18: (dec, 4 sc) around - 30

Rnd 19: (dec, 3 sc) around - 24

Rnd 20: (dec, 2 sc) around - 18

Rnd 21: (dec, sc) around - 12

Rnd 22: (dec) around - 6

Cut tail and pull through. Sew around circle and pull tight to close.



Head Construction

Insert head through the face hole of the fleece and fish horns and ears through the holes made in the fleece.

Add stuffing to puffs in the side of the head and top of the head to add more volume.

Stitch around face opening to secure head.

Attach eyes and use black yarn to create v-shaped mouth



Body Construction

Sew arms onto the top of the body directly across from each other.

Sew legs to the body parallel to each other close to the back.

Attach fleece/head to body with loose whip stitches and pull to secure. This is the most fiddly part of the whole piece.

Use tail from bell to secure cape around body.
