## Yarn Color A - Sugarwheel Cotton: Any! <br> Color B - Sugarwheel Cotton: Soft <br> Gardenia

Hook Size F/5-3.75mm Hook

## Gauge None

Extras Stuffing, Catnip, Embroidery Needle, Scissors

## Abbreviations

- sc - single crochet
- wc - waistcoat stitch
- inc - increase waistcoat stitch
- dec-decrease waistcoat stitch
- hdc - half double crochet
- ( ) - repeat stitches in ( ) around or as many times as specified


## Waistcoat Stitch

The waistcoat stitch is what creates a great, dense fabric for this project and keeps all but the most determined cats from pulling stuffing loose.

A waistcoat stitch is worked identically to a single crochet, except you go through the post of the next single crochet, under the horizontal bar and between the legs

## Pattern Notes

All rounds are worked in a spiral unless otherwise mentioned. All stitches are worked in the waistcoat style unless otherwise mentioned.

## Instructions

Use Color A
Magic Ring
Rnd 1: 7 sc in Magic Ring - (7)
Rnd 2: (inc) around - (14)
Rnd 3: (inc, wc) around - (21)
Rnd 4: (inc, 2 wc ) around - (28)
Rnd 5-6: (wc) around - (28)
Join Color B
Rnd 7: blo: (dec, 2 wc ) around - (21)
Rnd 8: (dec, wc) around - (18)
Rnd 9: (dec) around - (14)
Stuff with stuffing of choice and catnip, if desired

Rnd 10: (dec) around - (7)
Slip stitch and cut 12 " tail. Pull tail through slip stitch.


## Use Color B

Rnd 1: Sc 6 stitches around the base of the mushroom-6

Rnd 2-3: (wc) around - (6)
Rnd 4: (sl st) around - (6)
Rnd 5: (wc) around - (6)
Rnd 6: (inc, 2 wc ) around - (8)
Rnd 7-11: (wc) around - (8)
Stuff with stuffing of choice and catnip, if desired.

Rnd 11: (dec) around - (4)
Slip stitch and cut tail, pull tail through, and weave in ends.

Join another length of Color B into the sl st on Rnd 4

Rnd 12: Ch 2, 2 hdc in same space, 3 sc in next space, ( 3 hdc in next space, 3 sc in next space) twice, sl st to join round - (18)

Cut tail and pull through to secure. Pull tails through body to hide.
