# Magical Mushroom Lanyard



Yarn Sugarwheel Cotton
Hook Size F/5 -3.75mm Hook
Gauge None
Extras Scissors, Yarn Needle

#### **Abbreviations**

- sc single crochet
- wc waistcoat stitch
- inc increase waistcoat or single crochet stitch
- dec decrease waistcoat or single crochet stitch
- hdc half double crochet
- blo back loop only
- () repeat stitches inside parentheses around or number of times specified

#### Waistcoat Stitch

The waistcoat stitch is what creates a great, dense fabric for this project.

A waistcoat stitch is worked identically to a single crochet, except you go **through** the post of the next single crochet, under the horizontal bar and between the legs

#### **Notes**

This pattern is split into three different sections: cap, base, and lanyard. Feel free to mix and match!

All patterns are worked in a spiral unless otherwise specified.

I've also included a few decoration options if you want to add some spots.



### **Lanyard Instructions**

**OPTION A: I-Cord** 

Step 1: Chain 3



**Step 2:** Skip 1 chain, insert hook into the next chain. Wrap the yarn over and pull up a loop. Insert hook into the next chain, wrap yarn and pull up a loop. You should have three loops on the hook.



**Step 3:** Remove the first two loops on the hook. Hold them with your thumb and index finger to make sure they don't slip back through.



**Step 4:** Wrap yarn and pull up a loop. **Step 5:** Insert hook into second loop, wrap yarn, and pull up a loop.





**Step 6:** Insert hook into last loop, wrap yarn, and pull up a loop.

Repeat from Step 3 until your lanyard is 24" or desired length.

#### **OPTION B: Chain**

\*\* I wouldn't recommend this cord for a heavier item

**Step 1:** Ch until desired length is reached, around 24 inches.

**Step 2:** Cut long tail and pull through final chain to secure.



## **Cap Instructions**

#### Cap One

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, wc) around - 9

Rnd 3: (inc, 2 wc) around - 12

Rnd 4: (inc, 3 wc) around - 15

Rnd 5: (inc, 4 wc) around - 18

\*\* Rnd 6 makes lanyard holes\*

Rnd 6: (ch 2, 7 wc) around - 18

Rnd 7: (inc, 2 wc) around - 24

Rnd 8: (inc, 3 wc) around - 30

Rnd 9: (inc, 4 wc) around - 36

Rnd 10-11: (wc) around - 36

Rnd 12: (dec, 4 wc) around - 30

Rnd 13: (dec, 3 wc) around - 24


SI st, cut long 18" tail, and pull through to secure.

Thread the tail onto a large yarn needle. Flip cap inside out and fold edge up. Whip stitch edge into place.

















## **Cap Instructions**

#### Cap Two

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc) around - 12

Rnd 3: (wc) around - 12

Rnd 4: (inc, wc) around - 18

\*\* Rnd 5 makes lanyard holes\*

Rnd 5: (ch 2, 7 wc) around - 18

Rnd 6: (inc, 2 wc) around - 24

Rnd 7-13: (wc) around - 24

SI st, cut long 18" tail, and pull through to

secure.

Thread the tail onto a large yarn needle. Flip cap inside out and fold edge up. Whip stitch edge into place.

















## **Cap Instructions**

#### **Cap Three**

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, wc) around - 9

Rnd 3: (wc) around - 9

Rnd 4: (inc, 2 wc) around - 12

Rnd 5: (wc) around - 12

Rnd 6: (inc, 3 wc) around - 15

Rnd 7: (wc) around - 15

Rnd 8: (inc, 4 wc) around - 18

\*\* Rnd 9 makes lanyard holes\*

Rnd 9: (ch 2, 7 wc) around - 18

Rnd 10: (inc, 5 wc) around - 21

Rnd 11: (wc) around - 21

Rnd 12: (inc, 6 wc) around - 24

Rnd 13: (inc, 3 wc) around - 30

Rnd 14: (inc, 4 wc) around - 36

Rnd 15-16: (wc) around - 36

Rnd 12: (dec, 4 wc) around - 30

Rnd 13: (dec, 3 wc) around - 24

SI st, cut long 18" tail, and pull through to secure.

Thread the tail onto a large yarn needle. Flip cap inside out and fold edge up. Whip stitch edge into place.

















#### **Base Instructions**

#### Base One (Lighter/Chapstick/Juul)

\*\*Note for Base: Weave in the tail from your magic ring early as these may be difficult to flip inside out the weave in later

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (wc, inc, wc) around - 9

Rnd 3: (wc, 3 inc, wc) around, sl st to join

round, ch 1 - 16

Rnd 4: (hdc blo) around - 16

Rnd 5: (sl st) around - 16

\*\* Rnd 6 is worked in the tops of the hdc from rnd 4. not in the sl st

Rnd 6: (sc) around - 16

Rnd 7: (sl st) around - 16

\*\* Rnd 8 is worked in the tops of the sc from rnd 6, not in the sl st

Rnd 8: (sc) around - 16

Rnd 9-15: (wc) around - 16

\*\* adjust number of rows for height as needed

Rnd 16: (sl st) around - 16

Rnd 17: (sl st) around - 16

SI st, cut tail, and pull through to secure.













#### **Base Instructions**

#### Base Two (AirPods)

Foundation: ch 5

Rnd 1: sk st, 3 sc, sc 3 times in next stitch (first chain), 3 sc, sc 3 times in next stitch (5th chain) - 12

Rnd 2: (3 wc, inc, wc, inc) around - 16

Rnd 3: (3 wc, inc, 3 wc, inc) around - 20

Rnd 4-9: (wc) around - 20

\*\* adjust number of rows for height as needed

Rnd 10: (sl st) around - 20

\*\* rnd 11 is worked by inserting hook under sl st from round 10 and through top of stitches from the round previous, see photo

Rnd 11: (sl st) around - 20

SI st, cut tail, and pull through to secure.















#### **Base Instructions**

## Base Three, Moss Stitch (AirPods/Elfbar)

Foundation: ch 5

Rnd 1: sk st, 3 sc, sc 3 times in next stitch (first chain), 3 sc, sc 3 times in next stitch (5th chain) - 12

Rnd 2: (3 wc, inc, wc, inc) around - 16

Rnd 3: (3 wc, inc, 3 wc, inc) around - 20

Rnd 4: (wc) around - 20

Rnd 5: (sl st) around - 20

\*\* Rnd 6 is worked in the tops of the sc from rnd 4, not in the sl st

Rnd 6: (sc) around - 20

\*\* Start moss stitch, adjust number of rounds as needed for heigh

Rnd 7-11: (sc, ch) around - 20

Rnd 12: (sc) around - 20

Rnd 13: (sl st) around - 20

\*\* rnd 14 is worked by inserting hook under sl st from round 10 and through top of stitches from the round previous, see photo

Rnd 14: (sl st) around - 20

SI st, cut tail, and pull through to secure.

















## **Assembly Instructions**

Using a yarn needle, secure one end of the lanyard to the inside of the base. Use hook to pull lanyard up through one hole on the cap and down through the other.

Attach other end of lanyard opposite the first on the inside of the base.







#### **Decoration Instructions**

#### **Small Stitches**

Using a contrasting yarn and yarn needle, securely attach yarn with a knot to the inside of the cap.

Pull yarn up through cap to outside. Create loop with yarn and insert needle back near the same hole and pop it to the outside about 1/4" away. Pull needle though, making sure the loop is still around the working yarn.

Insert needle back to the inside of the cap immediately in front of where it came out, on the outside of the loop.

Secure yarn before making any more.

#### **Spots**

Chain stitch in a circle, any size

Repeatedly stitch from one side to the other in the center of the chains in a star pattern to fill in center.
