Rhubarb Pie



Yarn

Color A - Yarn Bee Sugarwheel Cotton Solids - Merlot

Color B - DK Weight Cotton Yarn - Light Brown

I used a light brown from a Sugarwheel Cotton

Hook Size F

Gauge None

Abbreviations

- ch chain stitch
- sc single crochet
- inc increase stitch
- dec decrease stitch
- sl st slip stitch
- sk st skip stitch
- blo back loop only
- flo front loop only
- * repeat around

Waistcoat Stitch

In this pattern, I use a waistcoat stitch instead of a single crochet to make the Pie Filling and Pie Base, but for ease of readability, I am leaving the abbreviations as sc throughout.



Instructions

Pie Filling

Make Magic Ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: inc * - 12

Rnd 3: inc, sc * - 18

Rnd 4: inc, 2 sc * - 24

Rnd 5: inc, 3 sc * - 30

Rnd 6: sc * - 30

Slip stitch to join last round, cut tail and pull

through to secure

Lattice (Make 6)

Rnd 1: ch 15

Turn work

Rnd 2: sl st 15

Cut long tail, ~12", and pull through to secure

We'll use the tail to sew the lattice to the pie

filling









Pie Base

Make Magic Ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: inc * - 12

Rnd 3: inc, sc * - 18

Rnd 4: inc, 2 sc * - 24

Rnd 5: inc, 3 sc blo * - 30

Rnd 6-9: sc * - 30

Rnd 10: dec, 3 sc blo * - 24

Rnd 11 - 3 hdc in next st flo of round 9, sk st,

sl st * - 10 petals

Slip stitch to join last round, cut tail and pull $\,$

through to secure











Assembly

Pin Lattices to Pie Filling in woven pattern and use long tails to stitch the Lattices in place.

Place Pie Filling with attached Lattices into the Pie Base. Use a piece of Color B to stitch through round 10 of the Pie Base to the edges of Pie Filling, stuffing when you have about an inch of an opening left.

Tie off your piece of Color B and pull through the pie, cutting close to the pie to hide the tail.
