Yarn **Worsted Weight Yarn** in colors:

White

Red

Pink

Dark Pink

Black

Blue

Hook **Size F/5 -3.75mm Hook**

Gauge **None**

Extras **Scissors, Stuffing, Yarn Needle,**

Abbreviations

- sc - single crochet
- wc - waistcoat stitch
- inc - increase waistcoat or single crochet stitch
- dec - decrease waistcoat or single crochet stitch
- sl st - slip stitch
- () - repeat stitches inside parentheses around or number of times specified

Waistcoat Stitch

The waistcoat stitch is what creates a great, dense fabric for this project.

A waistcoat stitch is worked identically to a single crochet, except you go **through** the post of the next single crochet, under the horizontal bar and between the legs

Notes

This pattern is worked in a spiral, we will never join rounds, just keep going!

The start of the body may feel really triangular! I made this choice so the body can sit a little lower and support itself despite the crazy angles of the legs.

Santa Hat Instructions



Ball

Using White

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, wc) around - 12

Rnd 3-5: (wc) around - 12

Stuff

Rnd 6: (dec around) - 6

Sl st, cut tail and pull through to secure. Use tail to weave around circle and pull tight.

Hat



Using Red

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, 2 wc) around - 8

Rnd 3: (inc, 3 wc) around - 10

Rnd 4: (inc, 4 wc) around - 12

Rnd 5: (inc, 5 wc) around - 14

Rnd 6: (inc, 6 wc) around - 16

Rnd 7: (inc, 7 wc) around - 18

Rnd 8: (inc, 8 wc) around - 20

Rnd 9: (inc, 9 wc) around - 22

Rnd 10: (inc, 10 wc) around - 24

Rnd 11: (inc, 11 wc) around - 26

Rnd 12: (inc, 12 wc) around - 28

Rnd 13: (inc, 13 wc) around - 30

Rnd 14: (inc, 14 wc) around - 32

Rnd 15: (inc, 15 wc) around - 34

Rnd 16: (inc, 16 wc) around - 36

Rnd 17-19: (wc) around - 36



Join White

Rnd 20: (sl st) around - 36

** Rnd 21 is worked in the white slip stitches

Rnd 21: (sc) around - 36

Rnd 22: (inc, 5 wc) - 42

Rnd 23-25: (wc) around - 48

Rnd 26: (dec, 6 wc) - 42

Rnd 27: (dec, 5 wc) - 36

Sl st, cut extra long tail, and pull through to secure.

Fold the white brim inwards and thread tail onto a yarn needle.

Use this tail to whip stitch the white to the tops of the last round of red.

Use the tail from the ball to secure it to the top of the hat.

Body

Using Pink

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc) around - 12

Rnd 3: (wc) around - 12

Rnd 4: (inc, wc) around - 18

Rnd 5: (wc) around - 18

Rnd 6: (inc, 2 wc) around - 24

Rnd 7: (wc) around - 24

Rnd 8: (inc, 3 wc) around - 30

Rnd 9: (wc) around - 30

Rnd 10: (inc, 4 wc) around - 36

Rnd 11-16: (wc) around - 36

Rnd 17: (dec, 4 wc) around - 30

Rnd 18: (wc) around - 30

Rnd 19: (dec, 3 wc) around - 24

Rnd 20: (wc) around - 24

Rnd 21: (dec, 2 wc) around - 18

Rnd 22: (wc) around - 18

Stuff

Rnd 23: (dec, wc) around - 12

Rnd 24: (wc) around - 12

Rnd 25: (dec) around - 6

Sl st, cut tail and pull through to secure. Use tail to weave around circle and pull tight.





Feet (make 2)

Using Dark Pink

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, wc) around - 9

Rnd 3: (inc, 2 wc) around - 12

Rnd 4: (inc, 3 wc) around - 15

Rnd 5: (inc, 4 wc) around - 18

Rnd 6-11: (wc) around - 18

Stuff lightly

Rnd 14: (dec, wc) around - 12

Rnd 15: (wc) around - 12

Rnd 15: (dec) around - 6

Sl st, cut tail and pull through to secure. Use tail to weave around circle and pull tight.



Arms (make 2)

Using Pink

Make magic ring, ch 1

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring - 6

Rnd 2: (inc, wc) around - 9

Rnd 3: (inc, 2 wc) around - 12

Rnd 4-6: (wc) around - 12

Sl st, cut extra long tail and pull through to secure. We'll use the tail to attach the arms and stuff them during the assembly process.

Assembly Instructions

Use tails of arms and legs to whip stitch onto body. See photo for position suggestions. I wanted more of an action pose.

Stuff the arms once they are half attached.

For the legs, you can tack them to the body in other places to keep them in position.

I made my Kirby basically doing the splits.



Face

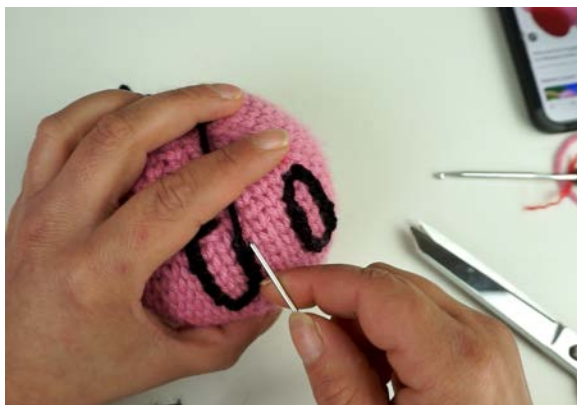
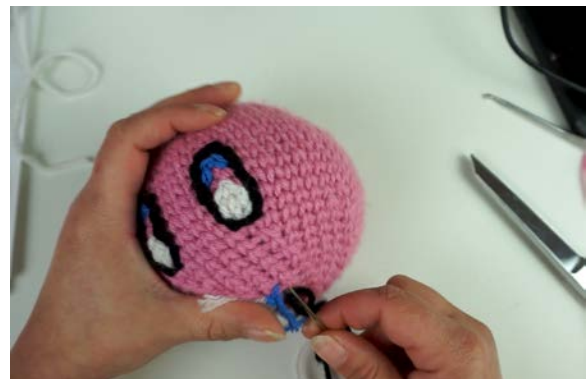
I used a simple chain stitch for all of the facial features

Use black to chain stitch around outside of eyes, roughly 2 wc stitches wide and 6 stitches tall.

Use white to create eye highlights. I did three chain stitches down from the top of the eye, three stitches up, then one in the middle to fill in a little bit.

Use blue to fill in the bottom of the eyes, I did three chain stitches in a U shape following the bottom of the eye.

Fill in the rest of the eyes with black.



Use dark pink to embroider cheeks, 5 stitches along the top, 5 along the bottom, and two in the middle to fill in.

Use red to embroider rounded triangle for mouth. I spiraled around with chain stitches in the middle to fill in the mouth.

Finally, tack the hat into place! I also put a tack on the back of the hat to help it hold the bend.
